Rang a total of 505 peals

His notable achievements include ringing in a silent and non-conducted peal of Cambridge Surprise Maximus (Cripplegate, 10.3.1973); ringing in the funeral peal for Sir Winston Churchill at St Paul's Cathedral (26.1.1966).

He was a ringing historian.
